The travel Bursary to participate in the World Conference on Timber Engineering funded by Forest and Wood Products Australia through their WoodSolutions brand

In August (22 to 25 August), a group of Australian engineering post graduate research students will be invited to travel to the World Conference on Timber Engineering (WCTE 2016) in Vienna, Austria. The study tour is being supported by the Forest and Wood Products Australia Ltd (FWPA).

This is an opportunity for our best and brightest engineering post graduate students to be inspired by attending the peak international timber engineering event.

The potential students must be undertaking a Masters or PhD with Timber as the main theme of the research. The additional funds will assist with expenses in attending (travel/accommodation).

Applicants need to answer the following questions in not more than one A4 page and include that in their applications.

- Why are you interested in participation in the World Conference on Timber Engineering?
- Why should we send you to the World Conference on Timber Engineering?

• How would you spread the knowledge and information that you obtain during the conference?

Also the one page should contain details of the timber themed research being undertaken by the applicant, their contact details, the University they attend, school and facility. As well the University's supervisor of the applicant must be included for verification purposes.

It is also expected that the selected students use twitter and Facebook during the conference and post conference, will write a short report on their experience for the FWPA.

The application deadline is 1st July, 2016.

All applicants must be Australian citizens or have residence status. Applicants with student visa only are not eligible to apply. Evidence of residence status maybe requested.
